Column	Content
Total	Number (N) and weighted percentage (unless your data are unweighted) for the total sample by grade and by race/ethnicity.
Age Group	Number (N) and weighted percentage (unless your data are unweighted) for each age group by grade and by race/ethnicity.
Missing	The number of students in each subgroup that did not answer the question used to identify members of that subgroup.
